

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR LANDHOLDERS

Deferral of land rents due to natural disaster declarations

The Queensland Government is ensuring disaster affected communities receive the support and assistance they need to recover from the unprecedented North Queensland monsoon trough.

Landholders within the areas declared for assistance under the Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements will receive assistance via deferral of land rent.

Deferral of rent

All rental invoices, with due dates ranging from **1 March 2019 to 30 November 2019**, will receive an extension to **1 December 2019**, without incurring any late payment penalty.

Landholders don't have to do anything further to take up this offer of assistance.

During this time you may still make full or partial payments.

Further extensions

If you are still suffering hardship past 1 December 2019 as a result of natural disaster, you may apply for extended hardship for 12 months under section 40E of the *Land Regulation 2009* if your tenure is not a Permit to Occupy.
